We count it a privilege and a blessing to be your missionary and more importantly called of God to the Australian people. It seems that today is a time when people want nothing to do with God. It reminds me of **Jeremiah 17:23 But they obeyed not, neither inclined their ear, but made their neck stiff, that they might not hear, nor receive instruction.** BUT I thank God, He is in control and that He has given us a message of hope to a lost and dying world.

We have had several visitors to services these last two months. A man who had just lost his wife and was there for comfort came and I was able to witness to him at length after services. A lady came to services and Praise God she has been back several times. She is a professor of Veterinary Radiology at James Cook University. My wife and I talked with her and she claims to be saved. She is from South Africa and seems very interested in attending.

We had a wonderful but hot Christmas (it was 100 degrees here). I cannot believe I am saying this but I miss the cold during Christmas. We were able to face time with our family during this time which was a blessing. I pray that you had a wonderful and blessed Christmas.

Please continue to pray for us to reach souls and for our health.

Lastly my laptop finally died. It had the blue screen of death, so I lost all of my previous prayer letter I sent out. I am starting to save them to my google drive cloud.
