We also had a man from Mexico, named Bro. Armando, spending time with our family and staying in our home right around the turn of the New Year. I was able to take him to visit and help me witness in a Spanish home where I had been trying since the summer to reach a Mexican family. The result – Bro. Armando was able to lead three souls to Christ in that home and one of those men named Luis has been in Sunday School and church services with us since then. Please pray that the entire household would be saved and start coming to church and growing in the Lord. The grandparents in the home are Luis and Lety Valencia. Their son's name is Erik, and Erik's wife is Sandra, and then their two young children are Allan and Emilio. Sandra is the one who has been most resistant each time I have visited the home and seems to want to remain staunch in her Catholicism. Pray that God would soften her heart.

On January 6<sup>th</sup>, in our nursing home ministry, I was able to share the Gospel; and a new staff member in the nursing home, a lady named Ciara, prayed with me to trust Christ as her Saviour. What a blessing this was!
